WE WILL, on request, bargain collectively with Washington Mailers' Union No. 29 as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of unit employees regarding any changes in wages, hours, and terms and conditions of employment, including the assignment of bargaining unit work, to the full extent required by the National Labor Relations Act.
